### N-SIPI 2017


### Improvements over 2016

- Larger firm sample across major states
- Higher response ratio
- Adequate replacement strategy
- Time frame aligned with beginning of the fiscal year
- Timed just before introduction of GST
- Improved perceptions through weighted responses



### Ownership type




### **Industry sector**






### Firm size distribution

















### Firms' financial position









### **Expansion intentions**


